TEACHER'S CORNER

With Mrs. Heimer

Second graders have mastered many skills just in time to begin learning new ones.

In **penmanship**, all the lowercase cursive letters have been learned and capital letter practice has begun.

In **religion**, students learned about the season of Lent and are now beginning to study the parts of the Mass in preparation for First Communion.

In **Science** students have completed their second PLTW module that covered plants, seeds and pollination and will soon begin studying the changes on Earth.

The students have completed the review of all addition facts and have a good start on the subtraction facts. Some skills they are covering are telling time to the closest 5 minutes and temperature to the nearest 2 degrees, mastering Venn diagrams, adding with regrouping, and money counting, and working on measuring to the nearest inch to half inch.

Reading has introduced a wide variety of topics. In the last few weeks they have read stories about snow days, kindness, and President Lincoln. This week they are reading about a man who escaped from slavery. The students are able to pick apart the words and sentences to learn more about how to write a story. They used those skills to create their own story about being trapped in a snow globe. And of course, they are being exposed to many new words which helps them become better spellers too.

In **Social Studies** they have completed a history unit and are now looking closely at Earth with the use of maps and globes.

Students keep busy in the classroom, art room, gym, music room, and out at recess. It's hard to believe the school year is more than half over with many things left to learn in preparation for 3rd grade.
